

Secondary Plant List

Non-native ornamentals [beware, these plants require extra maintenance]

- Artemisia - *Artemisia stelleriana* 'Silver Brocade'
- Aster - *Aster novi-belgii* 'Prof. Kippenburg'
- Snow-in-summer - *Cerastium tomentosum*
- Spiderflower - *Cleome* 'Rose Queen'
- Crocoshmia - *Crocoshmia* ssp. (has naturalized along parts of the coast)
- Maiden Pink - *Dianthus deltoides* 'Zing Rose'
- Blue fescue - *Festuca ovina glauca*
- Daylily - *Hemerocallis* 'Stella d'Oro'
- Lavender - *Lavandula* 'Munstead'
- Petunia - *Petunia* 'Carpet Series White'
- Rugosa Rose - *Rosa rugosa* - (to be trained on walls, fences)
- Lavender Cotton - *Santolina chamaecyparissus*
- Stonecrop - *Sedum rosea*
- Nasturtium - *Tropaeolum majus*

Wildflowers [from Wilbur's list, but not recommended by Landscape Committee 2001, for reasons of excessive maintenance. For dedicated gardeners only!]

- Yarrow - *Achillea millefolium*
- Pearly Everlasting - *Anaphalis margaritacea*
- Columbine - *Aquilegia formosa*
- Sea Pink - *Armeria maritima*
- Common California - *Aster chilensis*
- Harvest Brodiaea - *Brodiaea coronaria*
- Larkspur - *Delphinium menziesii*
- Seaside Daisy - *Erigeron glaucus*
- California Poppy - *Eschscholzia californica*
- Oregon Iris - *Iris tenax*
- Tiger Lily - *Lilium columbianum*
- Lupine - *Lupinus latoralis*
- Beach Evening Primrose - *Oenothera contorta*
- Buttercup - *Ranunculus occidentalis*
- Bluff Mallow - *Sidalcea hirtipes*

Caution

English Ivy - (*Hedera helix*) is an invasive non-native considered a noxious weed by many, and is unacceptable.

Scotch Broom - (*Cytisus scoparius*) is also an invasive, introduced species and crowds out our native plants. Its growth and spread should be discouraged.
